ON THE BEACHES AND SHORES ADVISORY BOARD

The Town Commission by Resolution established a Beaches and Shores Advisory Board for the residents of the Town of Highland Beach. The duties and responsibilities of the Beaches and Shores Advisory Board are as follows:

- Coordinate activities related to regular beach clean-up events.
- Assist the Sea Turtle program with activities related to the program and recruitment of volunteers;
- Conduct periodic reviews of Ordinances and polices related to beaches and sea turtle and make recommendations to the Town Commission regarding amendments to same;
- Assist in effort to encourage homeowners and associations to keep adequate levels of vegetation on the beach in order to avoid erosion;
- Make recommendations about regulations related to beach cleaning as the Board sees fit;
- Assist the Town Commission, upon the Commissions request, with items and issues related to waterways within the corporate limits of Highland Beach including boat wakes, manatee protection and mangroves;
- Perform other assignments requested by the Town Commission.

This VACANCY will be filled by the Town Commission.
